Technical Assistance (TA) Consultant Support

- **55 of 55 (100%)** trained, local TA Consultants have successfully set up Consultant accounts.
- **34 (62%)** of these 55 Consultants are AZ Health Zone Local Implementing Agency staff.
- We have updated the Arizona TA Consultant flyer with training sessions available through September 2022.

Early Care & Education (ECE) Provider Registration

- **76 of 75 (101%)** planned ECEs were enrolled in the Year 3 statewide Go NAPSACC program as of 6/29/22; all received the Go NAPSACC Research Information Sheet, and 75 received a \$20 Amazon gift code.

Arizona ECE Systems Integration

Between March and June 2022, our team continued to support the integration of the Empower Plus+ 2.0 Go NAPSACC Program into the Arizona state ECE system. We:

- (1) Worked to improve Consultant reporting of TA activity in the Go NAPSACC portal.
- (2) Implemented the revised ECE recruitment processes using Google forms.
- (3) Supported the state administrator's final ECE recruitment pushes by increasing our frequency of communication with interested ECEs and AZ Health Zone Consultants.
- (4) Developed a plan to emphasize the Go NAPSACC as a 5-step improvement cycle (versus an assessment) for Consultants to enhance messaging to ECEs.
- (5) Began to talk to AZ Health Zone Consultants about the integration of continuing education credits into the state systems from Go NAPSACC training participation.
